Request Description: On May 1, 2020, the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) published the Interoperability and Patient Access final rule. This rule modifies the Medicare Conditions of Participation (CoP) to now require hospitals to implement admission, discharge, and transfer (ADT) event notifications. This requirement will be implemented on May 1st, 2021.

New Workflow: Provider will begin to receive in-basket messages for additional ADT types. Currently, ADT events are sent to a provider for admissions only and this would happen only if they were not the admitting provider. Now the PCP will be notified of all admissions and transfers. Providers can request to be alerted for discharges, however we are not automatically turning this on since providers receive the discharge summary in Epic already.


