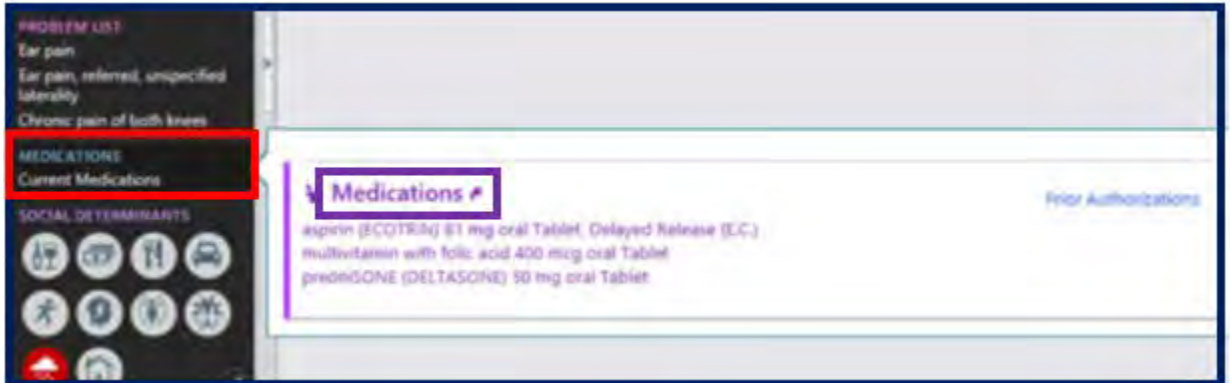

1. Medications on Storyboard Request by many physicians and Advance Practice Providers



If you click on the MEDICATIONS title in the storyboard (Red Box), you will be launched to Meds in Chart Review.

A hover bubble will appear when you hover over Medications area. Clicking the Medications title (Purple Box) in the hover bubble will launch you to Meds & Orders when in an encounter, or to Meds in Chart Review if not in an encounter.

If patient does not have any current outpatient medications it will display as 'None'



- 2. Reducing Drug- Drug Alerts and BPA's** Important work is Continuing to improve the Clinical Decision Support provided in the EMR and eliminate unnecessary alerts. Clinical Decision Support Committee shared their work for the Month. They have been doing an amazing job analyzing the system BPA's, Drug-Drug and Drug-Disease alerts and other clinical decision support to improve the experience of our clinical staff.
 - Turn off Alert for Propofol and Ondansetron and Hydroxyzine (Decreases # of alerts by 282 per week)
 - Retired Multiple BPA's with Duplicative Action, obsolete function or workflow changes
 - Modification of BPA to allow ordering a single dose of insulin without being presented with the BPA to use the Insulin Order set
- 3. Change in InBasket Folders** Starting to combine CC'd results with Results folder to decrease the volume of Folders in the InBasket and allow more flexibility with creative solutions for care teams. Epic (Corporate) recommends that the CC'd Results and Results folders be combined. We are one of only a few organizations that still separate these folders. We are starting with the first step in combing the folders. We will discuss finalizing the combined folders in the next few months at EPAC. When CC'ing results, it

is important to only send if the physician/APP needs to see the results to take action or the information is very important to the patient's care. CC'ing routine tests can get in the way of providers ease to view important results that require action.

Here are the changes that Physicians/Advanced Practice Providers will see:

In the following scenarios, providers who previously received a CC'd Result would now receive a Results In Basket message. (The provider was NOT the authorizing provider on the order.)

1. CCH Family Health Center physicians will receive Results for any pathology order type result which was ordered by a Resident.
2. For currently admitted patients, all non-lab results are sent to the authorizing provider and the "Attending" provider. The attending provider will now receive a Result IB message.
3. For any test resulted after the patient has been discharged, the results are sent to the authorizing provider and the PCP. The PCP will now receive a Result IB message.
4. In ETC setting, results are sent to the authorizing provider and either a PA or APP pool. The PA's/APP's will now receive Results IB messages.

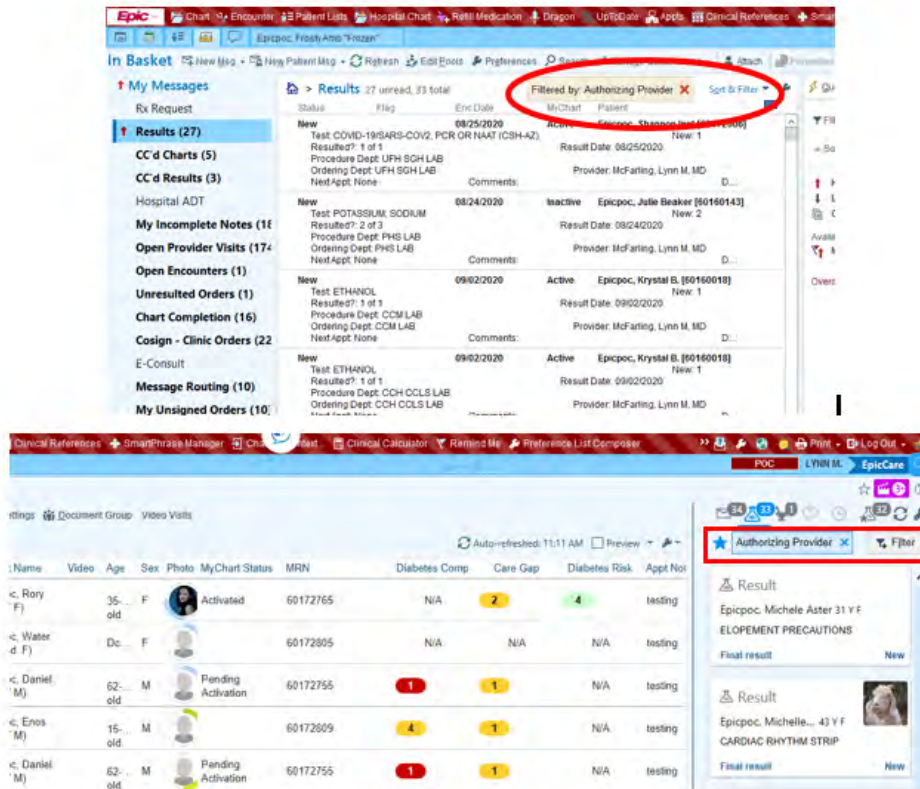

4. **Minor Protected Notes developed to Comply with 21st Century Cures Information Blocking** The new notes allow any Physicians or Advanced Practice Providers that care for children and adolescents to document **Protected services (Alcohol/Substance Abuse, Sexually Transmitted Infection and Contraception Request)** There will be smart text for HPI and A/P for these 3 items. The Complete note is called **Gen Minor Protected Services Note Complete [42115]**
