## 2. Expected date to dynamically update expiration date on orders.

Currently if a lab is ordered that contains a defaulted expiration date and the provider changes the expected date to a date after the expiration date- the expiration date clears automatically.

With this request the expiration date would dynamically change with the expected date one month after the expected date.

### Also Adding Buttons for 4 months and 6 weeks to Expected Date

*Behavior with update*

1. Grab a lab from a preference list with expected and expiration dates defaulted
2. Update expected date and expiration date changes automatically
  - a. Important to note these settings only work for expected dates set to display as buttons; meaning if I manually change expected date from 1 Month to "m+2", my expiration date will not change to m+3, even if LSD is setup like that.

## 3. New CMS Regulation Admission and Transfer (ADT : Admission, Discharge and Transfer) Events from Internal and External Hospitals will be sent to the Providers InBasket folder. **Providers can request to be alerted for discharges; however, we are not automatically sending since providers receive the discharge summary in Epic**

## 4. Case Request warning for Inpatient patient class When entering the case request order providers often **select the patient class option of Inpatient when a patient is currently not admitted**. The provider **should have chosen Surgery Admit** for patients that are not currently admitted but will be admitted following the procedure. This impact other areas as a pending preadmission is not created and may cause delays in authorizing a patient for surgery.
