Heparin-PF4 Ab Lab Test	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Request to restrict orders for the Heparin-PF4 Ab, Ig lab test to the Heparin-Induced Thrombocytopenia order set. No individual orders could be placed. • The Heparin-Induced Thrombocytopenia order set is not currently available at all CCH sites. • APPROVED with the intent to work with the other CCH sites to set them up to use the Heparin-Induced Thrombocytopenia Order set and then restrict ordering of the test to the Order set 	Lance McNab to follow up with other CCH sites to help establish the Order set at the other sites.
Well Child Note Standardization and SWYC	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • SWYC was not discussed today due to issues and will be brought back to a future meeting. • Several sites are currently using two separate notes, one nurse note and one provider note. This is not as efficient as using Make me the Author workflow. • Recommendation is to have a consistent workflow using Make me the Author where the Nurse starts the Well child note and the provider completes the note. • With a single Well Child note It will be easier for providers and coders to find information, reducing the number of queries to providers. • Approval of Well Child policy expected at the end of May, the proposed Go Live for the Standard Well Child note using Make me the Author is June 1st 2021. • Lynn Kissock, Heidi Albrecht, and Stacey Jorschumb and their teams will develop a concise tip sheet and work with Renee Doetkott and nursing to provide the needed training. • APPROVED 	No Follow up

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Yield/Soft Stop on Antibiotic Orders	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The proposal is to add a yield sign (soft stop) for the duration field on all antibiotic orders both IV and oral placed in an inpatient setting. • Reason for the request is to bring attention to duration of antibiotic therapy. • This was approved by SCH Antimicrobial Stewardship and SCH P&T committees recently. • It is for all sites system level. • APPROVED 	No follow up.
Neurology Consult Referral Order	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Goal is to help the Neurology Department be more efficient with scheduling patients. • Request the reason for Referral be completed. • New ask during the discussion was to add an indication for the consult of Concussion care • The buttons will help the Referral schedulers and Neurology department understand why the referral was placed, however they do not auto route the consult order to any different work lists. • Dr Ruggiero recommended providers give specialists additional important information for the consultant in the Comments section of the order. • APPROVED 	No follow up.
Patient List Quick Link Updates	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Quick links on the Patient list are available. The links will jump providers to different activities. • The Problem List link was opening a generic chart encounter and not the Inpatient encounter and we were not able to technically fix it, so it was removed. • Additional links were added as of April 27th including Rounding, Admission, Discharge, and Procedure navigators • The Notes and manage orders links will remain on the patient lists. • Using the links can help save clicks for providers. Vision & Hearing Screen Close Visit Validation in Well Child Visits	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Correctly documenting the Hearing & Vision screen qualifies the visit for an additional S0302 code. • The Vision and Hearing portions of the Well Child visit are often not completed. • To improve completion of these items a Hard stop Closed Visit validation point is requested to assure complete documentation for Hearing and Vision Screens. This change will improve the revenue stream. • Duplicate work in the notes were eliminated and workflow snags were removed from the Well Child notes. 	No follow up.

Remove Imaging Decision Support Tool from Ultrasound Exams	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> CareSelect (Imaging Decision Support tool) will be removing Ultrasound exams. No BPA or decision support for Ultrasound exams. Why the decision support is being removed: There have not been payment issues with indications for ultrasound studies CMS will not be requiring Ultrasounds to be part of the High-tech imaging decision support Rule in 1/22 This will be a big win for Inpatient and Outpatient providers saving clicks. Go Live will be June 1st. 	No follow up.
Surgery Supply Cost Reduction Tools	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Surgery Supply Cost Reduction Tools will be made available (but not required) for all surgeons regardless of their specialty. The goal is to help drive down surgery supply/implant costs. Go Live will be May 23rd with the Epic Upgrade. This will be system wide for Carris and CentraCare. Post Op Diagnosis Available in Procedure Navigator	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> With this new field providers will be able to indicate in a discreet manner the post op diagnosis in the Procedure Navigator. This will be available on May 23rd with the Epic Upgrade. It is a CMS requirement. This can be incorporated with Vincari (AI tool to help create documentation for post op notes). Meagan Ferrell is the project manager for the Vincari project. Project kickoff date TBD APPROVED 	No follow up.
Case Request additional field for Post Op Destination	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> An optional field has been developed for providers to indicate post op destination. The goal is to assist in coordination of beds and staffing. This will Go Live on May 23rd with the Epic Upgrade. APPROVED 	No follow up.
Exchange Images via Care Everywhere	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Images (AJPEG image) will be able to be exchanged with other organizations via Care Everywhere that have the functionality set up. Currently Mayo, Sanford 	No follow up.
