Opioid prescribing BPAs to align with MN State prescribing guidelines. Changes have been reviewed Through the Integrated Pain Steering Committee and will now provide information on the Morphine Mg Equivalent per prescription.

Retired BPA's: Multiple Best Practice alerts again retired. This is due to duplicated actions, obsolete function, or changes in workflows.
